He has played under G.Prêtre, R.Chailly, M.W.Chung, R.Muti, W.Sawallisch, V.Gergiev, L.Maazel, P.Boulez and Z.Mehta. He participated in the DVD of Mozart’s “GranPartita” under M°Muti.

He was a soloist at the Tokyo ClarinetFest2008, the last six ClarinetFest@2009-2014 (Porto, Austin, LosAngeles, Lincoln, Assisi, BatonRouge), the 2nd CostaRica Festival, the 1st and 2nd Peruvian Congreso Latinoamericanos, the 5th “Congreso de Madrid”, the Festival Guimarães 2012 and the 3rd Guatemala Festival 2013.

In 2009 he obtained his conducting diploma with D.Renzetti.

He has published “Venti Studi per Clarinetto Basso”, “Tuning” for winds (Suvini Zerboni), his version of V.Bucchi’s concerto and the CDs: “Suggestions”(Edipan) and “SoloNonSolo”(ParmaRecords).
